When on-site auditing is not possible, remote auditing offers a smart solution. It's like regular auditing, with some big advantages: it requires no physical presence of the auditor, it increases process efficiency and it reduces travel time and cost, while offering high levels of quality and service.

Arguably the biggest disadvantage of remote audits is the difficulty to conduct an audit of physical processes and equipment.
