VERIFYING

Whether a Training Course Provider or Auditor is legitimately registered with SAATCA is a crucial aspect of conducting business. To assist with this, SAATCA maintains an **official list of registered Training Course Providers and Auditors** on our website, helping you identify and avoid false claims of registration.



WARNING

Auditors or Training Course Providers who use counterfeit certificates or falsely claim SAATCA registration **must be reported**. Such practices may endanger end-users who rely on genuine, registered professionals and **undermine confidence** in legitimate certificate.



LEGAL NOTICE

In accordance with the Consumer Protection Act, No. 68 of 2008, such fraudulent activities constitute a criminal offence and may result in legal action.

ACTION REQUIRED

To verify the authenticity of a registration certificate, please check whether the auditor or training course provider name is listed on the SAATCA website or contact our office directly for confirmation.

CAUTION

Please remain vigilant of Auditors or Training Course Providers falsely claiming SAATCA registration or using counterfeit certificates. We rely on your cooperation to report such matters to SAATCA promptly.
