## Course Details

Understanding the updated requirements of ISO 14001:2026 (FDIS) is essential for anyone working with an Environmental Management System. This 1-day course provides a concise but comprehensive walkthrough of the revised EMS structure, major updates related to climate change, lifecycle perspective, leadership expectations, change-management planning, and expanded emergency-preparedness requirements. Participants will gain clarity on each clause of the standard and learn how these requirements influence the implementation, operation, and continual improvement of an EMS.

## Learning Objectives

This course equips students with the essential knowledge to understand and interpret the updated requirements of ISO FDIS 14001:2026. Participants will learn to:

- Understand how the 2026 revision enhances clarity, structure, and alignment with modern environmental priorities such as climate resilience, biodiversity, lifecycle assessment, and resource efficiency.
- Interpret clause-by-clause requirements, including the expanded expectations within Context of the Organization (Clause 4), where climate change, biodiversity, and resource-use considerations must now be explicitly evaluated.
- Recognize strengthened leadership responsibilities and accountability requirements introduced in the 2026 edition (Clause 5).
- Apply updated Planning requirements, including the dedicated new clause on change management (Clause 6.3) and broader identification of potential emergency situations.
- Understand updates to Support, Operations, Performance Evaluation, and Improvement, including expanded supplier-control expectations, clearer documentation requirements, and stricter audit-objective and management-review inputs.

## Who should attend?

- Environmental professionals getting introduced to Management Systems or interested in the changes in the new version of ISO 14001 (FDIS).
- Individuals who have any type of involvement with an organization's Environmental Management System.
- Individuals in charge of implementing changes to the new ISO 14001 version.
- Professionals seeking further qualifications in the near future, such as Internal or Lead Auditor.
- People interested in raising awareness about ISO FDIS 14001:2026 or training others within an organization.
- Managers and leaders, whose responsibility scope is impacted by the changes in ISO 14001.
